The platform will incorporate school-based teaching, learning and assessment resources to enhance English speaking proficiency among junior form students. The core learning pathway guides students from reading input to spoken output, with listening and writing serving as bridging skills that support vocabulary acquisition, idea organisation and language consolidation along the way.</p> <p>Target level: Form 1 – Form 3</p> <p>Number of accounts: Approximately 400 students and 15 teachers</p> <p>Project duration: May 2026 – April 2027</p> <p>Tenderers are required to provide the following services:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Authorisation/Development/Licensing of a cloud-based learning management system accessible on multiple devices (iPads, tablets, smartphones, desktops), compatible with the school's BYOD policy.</li> <li>2. 4. Designing and implementing AI-based speaking and writing tools, including:

- a. A speaking platform that allows students to practise and improve their pronunciation and fluency through interactive AI-driven activities, and receive immediate, detailed feedback on their spoken performance.
- b. A writing supporting tool that supports students in idea generation and language improvement through real-time suggestions aligned with the project objectives.
- c. Assessment tools that evaluate students' performance with reference to the school's own rubrics, provide personalised feedback, and generate analytical reports for teachers.
- d. A teacher dashboard to monitor and track students' ability and progress, and allow teachers to export performance data for planning purposes.
- e. Professional development workshops and student onboarding workshops.

- 1. A minimum of **10 years of proven experience** in the design and development of e-learning platforms for educational institutions.
- 2. A minimum of **5 years of demonstrated experience** in the application of AI in English language education.
- 3. Successful completion of **large-scale school-based or institution-based projects**.
- 4. The proposed curriculum consultant(s) must possess a minimum of **8 years of experience** in English curriculum design for Hong Kong schools and familiarity with the local teaching context.
- 5. The proposed IT team must demonstrate experience in developing scalable and stable cloud-based e-learning

platforms and AI tools, with a proven track record.

Tenderers are requested to provide the following documentation:

1. Company profile, including year of establishment and areas of specialisation.
2. Consultant and project team profiles, demonstrating the expertise, qualifications and relevant experience of proposed team members.
3. IT team experience in developing e-learning platforms and AI tools, with a proven track record in scalable and stable solutions.
4. Proof of **large-scale school-based or institution-based projects** successfully completed within the past 5 years.

A demonstration session may be required.

Remarks: Tenderers should take note that offers will be evaluated based on a comprehensive assessment. Partial offers will not be considered. The assessment criterion does not solely rely on "the lowest bid wins" principle.
